Session objectives:

- Harvesting vision and key ideas from the community to contribute to the future requirements of the European AI platform
- Contributing to community building towards a future European AI ecosystem.

Background of the workshop:

There is an initiative by the European Commission on "Building of a European AI on-demand platform" The main goal of this initiative is "to develop a European AI ecosystem bringing together the knowledge, algorithms, tools and resources available and making it a compelling solution for users, especially from non-tech sectors" and, in particular, to "mobilize the European AI community including researchers, businesses and start-ups to provide access to knowledge, algorithms and tools"

The Public-Private Partnership organisations euRobotics and Big Data Value (BDVA) support this initiative and join forces to support mobilising the European AI Community. All stakeholders interested in contributing to the future AI on-demand platform and ecosystem are welcome to join and contribute to this workshop. It is in the interest of the whole community to share ideas regarding the creation, operations and persistence of a European AI-on demand platform and the business ecosystem around it.
