ABOUT ERF2017

This 3-day event is the meeting point for decision makers, engineers, researchers, and a growing number of entrepreneurs and investors, as well as users and policy makers in the field of robotics from all over Europe and beyond.

After the inaugural meeting in San Sebastian in 2010, this annual robotics networking event, organised by eurobotics aisbl, has quickly become the most influential meeting of the European robotics community.


The exhibition will take place in the Cromdale Hall. The versatile Cromdale Hall provides 1,185m² of carpeted exhibition space.
