


DIH Network Consortia

- Partners deeply rooted in regional/national
- Network needs critical mass
- Create pan-European connections
- Purpose is to deliver broad range of services to the community
- Activities should aim at long-term sustainability
 - and include a business plan for the digital innovation hubs,
 - a plan
 - to attract investors,
 - to address training and skills development needs
 - and dissemination.
 - Use established networks like the Enterprise Europe Network and the NCP network when reaching out to SMEs
- Develop highly innovative, cross border experiments.
 - At least 50% of the budget should directly benefit SMEs or slightly bigger companies.
- Collaborate in building a network of Digital Innovation Hubs
 - covering most regions in Europe.





Pilots (2019-2020)






Example Timeline
